### What you need:

Toilet Rolls

Cone shape object for the top

Paint

Glue

### Instructions:

Using toilet roll tubes construct your castle together before gluing it to make sure it is the right shape you want.

Glue your toilet rolls together.

Once you are happy with the shape, let it set and dry before

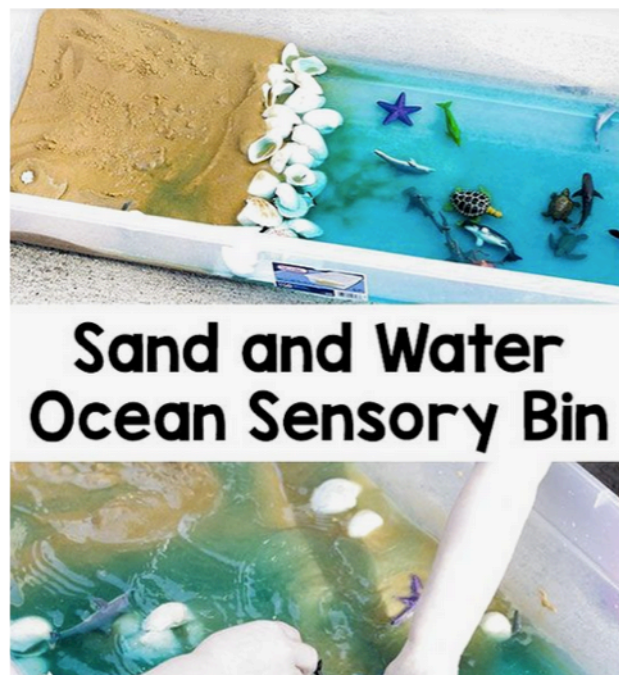
painting.

## Water & Sand



### What you need:

Water

Sand

Seaside toys

Shells

Pebbles

### Instructions:

Using a large tray/Tupperware fill half with sand. If you don't have sand you could use anything, brown rice could be a good substitute.

Fill the other half with water, and if you have it add some blue food colouring, to give that real ocean blue effect.

In the 'what you need', I have included different ideas to put within your tray but you can improvise to anything beach themed.

### **Ice Shaving Foam**



#### **What you need:**

Shaving Foam

Food Colouring

Sea life animals

#### **Instructions:**

Simply spray shaving foam into a container big enough to spray a decent amount but small enough to fit in the freezer. Add food colouring, preferably blue and stir to create a wave pattern.

Add your chosen toys into the shaving foam.

Put your shaving foam tray in the freezer, and leave until it gets to a crumbly consistency.

## **What you need:**

Kitchen Utensils

Paint

Paper

## **Instructions:**

Choose a variety of different kitchen utensils.

Put your paint into different tubs.

Enjoy dipping your utensils into paints and creating different patterns.

Items to fill your gloves

## **Instructions:**
