



## Egg Carton Flowers



### **What you need:**

Paint

Glue/Tape

Egg Cartons

Thick Paper Straws

### **Instructions:**

Using an empty four-pocket egg carton or a six and just cut the extra two off, choose your paint colours and begin to paint the bright colours into the egg carton. Making sure you paint the centre of the flower is a block colour.

Let your egg carton dry and then attach your colourful paper straw with glue or tape, I would suggest securing it with both.

## Magic Wand Reading Pointer



### What you need:

Lollypop Sticks

Decorations

Star

Glue

### Instructions:

Taking a lollypop stick and using gems, glitter, any items to decorate your magic wand. Then finish it off with a big star to be your pointer, of course you can use something else, but having a point like the star works a lot better.

## Lollypop Flower Pot



### What you need:

Empty Tin Can (make sure there are no sharp edges)

Lollypop Sticks

Bow

Plant to Pot

### Instructions:

Taking a clean empty tin can, stick your lollypop sticks around to create a pattern. Make sure they are stuck down securely.

Leave to dry and add your bow. Lastly choose a plant to pot.

## Colourful Name



## **What you need:**

Paper/Canvas

Paint

Masking Tape

## **Instructions:**

Firstly take your paper or canvas and map out your name using the masking tape, make sure it is firming down.

Then paint all over the paper including over your masking tape name.

Once you have finished your painting, peel off your tape to reveal your name, and then leave to dry.

## **Water Bead Sensory Bottle**



## **What you need:**

Water Beads

Empty Bottle

Water

Clear Hair Gel

## **Instructions:**

In a separate jug fill water half way, then add the clear hair gel, stir together and then carefully pour into your empty bottle. Add your water beads, you can also add glitter that also looks good for your sensory bottle. Put the lid back on the bottle and then test out your new sensory bottle by tipping upside down and watch the water beads slowly fall.
