What you need:

Cereal

Instructions:

This is a great sensory tray, as cereal makes great sounds, children can explore by crunching and bashing items to create different sounds, let them squeeze the cereals in their hands to feel the textures.

Toilet Roll Car



What you need:

Toilet paper tube

White paint

Paintbrush

Scissors

Hot glue/gun

4 lids

Markers, stickers, or paint

Instructions:

Cut a U shape in the cardboard tube to make the opening for toys to sit in the car. Fold the U up and cut it again to make it smaller.

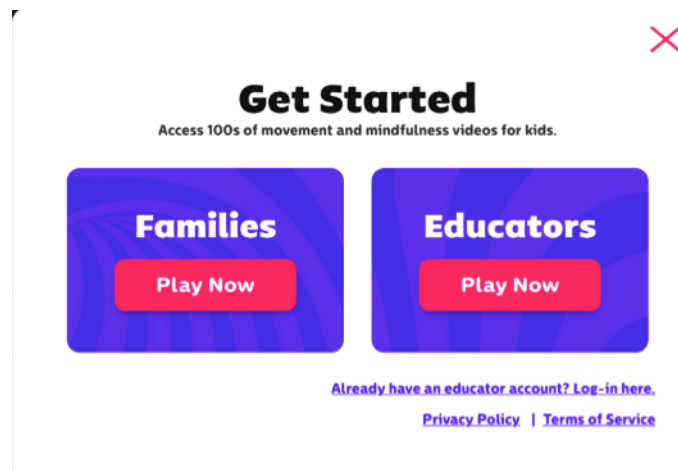
Paint the toilet paper tube white and set it out to dry.
